- 2) Read Hebrews 1:3. According to the Scripture, what did Jesus accomplish on the cross?

 - a) In each case, what are they given over to?
 - b) Read Romans 8:32. Who was given over or delivered up in this verse and for whom?
 - c) Read Romans 4:25. Who was given over or delivered up in this verse and for what reason?
- 4) If someone said to you that Jesus did not take the punishment for our sin on the cross because that would not be just for him to suffer for what we did, how would you respond? (Consider: Romans 3:23-26; 5:6-8; 8:37-39)
- When Jesus asks us to remember His death, He tells us that by it He is bringing in the New Covenant to our lives (1 Corinthians 11:23-25).
 - a) What is a covenant?
 - b) What are the terms of the New Covenant that Jesus secured for us by His blood according to Hebrews 8:6, 10-12?
 - c) How did Jesus' death secure each of these blessings for us?
- Read 1 Corinthians 15:20-26. Compare and contrast what Adam and Christ accomplished and how they accomplished it.

- 7) Read Romans 5:12-19. Compare and contrast what Adam and Christ accomplished and how they accomplished it. For example: What reigned as a result of Adam, and why? Who reigns as a result of Christ, and why?
- 8) According to 1 Peter 1:3, what blessing does the resurrection bring to our lives now?How does the resurrection bring that blessing to us?
